The Registration Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE for any reason.

2nd and more siblings get a free registration fee.

3. Payment Method for Lesson Fee

Lesson fee can be made using two options:

- 1. One-time Payment (August through May): \$792 / Due by July 15, 2025
- 2. Payment in two installments:
 - -1st Term Payment (August through December): \$432 / Due by July 15, 2025
 - -2nd Term Payment (January through May): \$432 / Due by December 15, 2025



*For those who join the class in the middle of the season, the lesson fee will be calculated as \$26 per lesson.

*The Lesson Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE for any reason.

No refunds will be given even if lessons are canceled due to severe weather, park closures, fear of infectious disease spreading, or any other reason.

Please make a payment by check. (Payable to ALOHA SOCCER SCHOOL).

We will charge \$20 for any returned (bounced) check.

4. Soccer Gear and What to Bring

Please always wear the Aloha Soccer School T-Shirt when you participate in practice.

Please wear your own soccer shorts and soccer socks. Any color is okay.

Please bring your own soccer ball, shin-guards, soccer shoes and water bottle.

(Ball Sizes : U6 to U8 players \Rightarrow Size 3 / U9 to U12 players \Rightarrow Size 4 / U13 players \Rightarrow Size 5)

5. Schedule

Our soccer school is a year-round program.

Practice will be held rain or shine. However, if there is severe weather, such as thunderstorms, we will cancel. In that case, you will receive an email notification one hour before practice.

The schedule is subject to change due to various reasons.

6. Absence

Please be sure to email us at info@aloha-soccer.com or text us at 808-383-0783 in advance if you will be absent. If you miss practices 4 weeks in a row without notice, we will consider this as a voluntary withdrawal of him/her from the class.

We are unable to accept any make-up sessions when you miss classes. And canceled classes will not be rescheduled.

7. Withdrawal

Please send notification by email no later than the 15th of the previous month if you would like to withdraw from class.

8. Responsibility

Parents are responsible for dropping off their children before class and picking them up after class.

Parents are also responsible for their children before and after practice. This includes the time before and after when their children are playing at the field or at the playground.

All members must have medical insurance to play. We will not provide any type of sports insurance.
